Re. MS: Update to Secretary Vilsack concerning genetic engineering

These comments to the National Organic Standards Board (NOSB) on its Fall 2016 agenda are submitted on behalf of Beyond Pesticides. Founded in 1981 as a national, grassroots, membership organization that represents community-based organizations and a range of people seeking to bridge the interests of consumers, farmers and farmworkers, Beyond Pesticides advances improved protections from pesticides and alternative pest management strategies that reduce or eliminate a reliance on pesticides. Beyond Pesticides supports the action of the NOSB to update the Secretary of Agriculture regarding its progress in preventing GMO incursion into organic production.
