2. Reduce size of ovarian reserve

- 1. Shortened reproductive lifespan
- 2. Increased infertility risk
- 3. Early menopause

Puberty

HOW PESTICIDES INTERFERE:

1. Disrupt brain signals/regulations that control puberty

OUTCOMES:

- 1. Changes in the timing of puberty
- 2. Higher number of early-onset puberty cases

3. Irregular Cycling

HOW PESTICIDES IN

- 1. Accelerate loss of dormant ovaria
- 2. Reduce density of ovarian reserv
- 3. Disrupt different hormone-regula maintenance

In Utero

HOW PESTICIDES INTERFERE:

- 1. Disrupt formation of primordial follicles
- 3. Alter fetal hormone production
